Learning about the Mass - 6

INTRODUCTORY RITE – MASS BEGINS

We have come and are ready to begin.

The Entrance Hymn starts and we join together in song.

Priest comes out, bows in reverence to the Cross and kisses the altar, to greet Jesus.

The priest goes to the Presider's Chair from where he leads us in prayer.

We begin our prayers together 'In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit', making the Sign of the Cross.

The priest then greets us 'The Lord be with You', reminding us God is with us and in us.

We reply 'And with Your Spirit', reminding him that God is with him and in him, too.

The priest then introduces the Mass and invites us to prepare our hearts in the Penitential Act.
