Learning about the Mass - 5

Arriving at the Church for Mass:

We bless ourselves with holy water at the entrance and remember that we are children of God.

We notice the red light where the altar is, and the tabernacle, where Jesus is present at all times.

We ‘genuflect’, go down on one knee, towards the tabernacle, to show our love and respect for Jesus who is present in the Blessed Sacrament.

We notice the cross which reminds of us of Jesus love for us and of his suffering and death.

We may also bow to the cross to show our respect and love for Jesus.

We take a Missalette or hymn sheet, so that we can join in the singing.

We greet our friends who are all part of God’s family.

We kneel to be quiet and pray.

We remember why we have come to praise and thank God and to pray for ourselves and others.

We are ready to begin celebrating Mass.
