DRESSING THE ALTAR

The Liturgy of the Eucharist begins by dressing the altar.

The altar table is the centre of God's house, the Church.

It is the centre of the special place in the Church called the Sanctuary.

Sanctuary means Holy.

The altar table is dressed with a white cloth, candles and, sometimes, flowers.

There is another smaller white cloth placed in the middle called the 'corporal'.

The dish with the bread for Mass, called the 'paten,' and the chalice are placed on it.

The big prayer book called 'The Missal' is also placed on the altar table.

There are also small white towels, to clean the paten and chalice after communion.
