

## **Third Weekend – Altar announcement** **4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> July 2015**

You have heard about ***Living the Joy of the Gospel*** at all Masses recently and one of our parish volunteers may have already called you to answer any questions you may have. ***Living the Joy of the Gospel*** is important for our Faith Community and for our parish. Your commitment is needed.

The Donnybrook ***Living the Joy of the Gospel*** campaign continues to receive generous support from many parishioners. To date, our parish has already received pledges of more than €1,610,000 towards our goal of €2,500,000. If you have decided to support ***Living the Joy of the Gospel***, we ask that you to complete a pledge form after Mass today to formalise and document your commitment. We are can achieve our goal. For example, 180 more families contributing €20 per week over a five year period will achieve our goal.

We are now approaching the final stages of the campaign and we plan to complete our efforts next weekend. Our plan has been to receive an informed decision from everyone in the parish and to date we have done well in contacting majority of parishioners. However, for those we were unable to reach but who wish to participate in ***Living the Joy of the Gospel***, material is available this week end and next week end at the exits of the Church, to enable you to do so.

Everyone is being invited to consider joining the campaign at a level appropriate to them so that together we can achieve great things for our present and future generations. Not everyone will join ***Living the Joy of the Gospel*** and we wouldn't expect this. As well as considering your decision about making a pledge, pray for the success of our campaign to build a new parish centre, upgrade and reorder the Church, improve car parking and contribute to a fund for the provision of a parish pastoral worker. These will strengthen our life as a faith community and build up our parish of Donnybrook for the future
