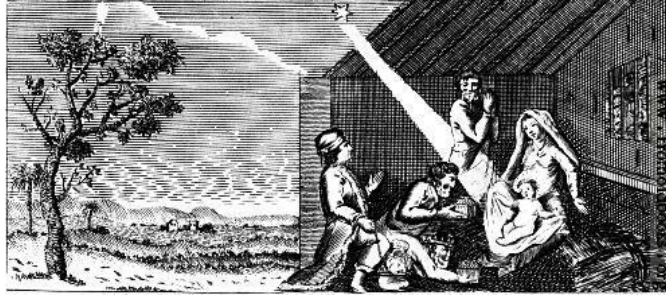

- Saturday (30<sup>th</sup> Dec) and Sunday (31<sup>st</sup> Dec) – Regular Mass Schedule.
- Monday (1<sup>st</sup> Jan) – Annual Diocesan Mass for Peace at 11:00am.
- Tuesday (2<sup>nd</sup> Jan) – Regular Mass Schedule resumes.

*Church will be closed at 12noon on week days unless there is a Wedding.*
