Tax rebates help pay the running costs of the parish which were €258,000 last year. The Tax Rebate on your recorded contributions last year was €49,000. Parishioners have suggested that we offer an alternative way of contributing so that contributions can be recorded and significantly increase the amount of the tax rebate, at no cost to the donors. We will provide envelopes for these collections from the beginning of July to those of you who wish to contribute in that way and who sign a form to let us know you want envelopes. The forms are available at the back of the Church.
