RE-OPENING OF CHURCH: Plans are in place to make our Church as safe a place as possible to come to Mass. Should we get the equipment and materials we have on order in time, we will be ready for public Masses on the 29th, at the usual times of 7.30 and 10. and for our regular schedule of Masses on the weekend of the 5th of July.

Should a family wish to have a baptism, funeral or wedding recorded, data protection requires that they request the Ceremony be recorded. The request should be made to the secretary at the parish office. There is a charge of €100 for this service.

This enables us to reclaim from the Revenue a tax rebate on your contributions over €250.
